THE OLD TESTAMENT LESSON: Genesis 39:1-21 (ESV)

Joseph had been brought down to Egypt, and Potiphar, an officer of Pharaoh, the captain of the guard, an Egyptian, had bought him from the Ishmaelites who had brought him down there. ²The Lord was with Joseph, and he became a successful man, and he was in the house of his Egyptian master. ³His master saw that the Lord was with him and that the Lord caused all that he did to succeed in his hands. ⁴So Joseph found favor in his sight and attended

him, and he made him overseer of his house and put him in charge of all that he had. ⁵From the time that he made him overseer in his house and over all that he had, the Lord blessed the Egyptian's house for Joseph's sake; the blessing of the Lord was on all that he had, in house and field. ⁶So he left all that he had in Joseph's charge, and because of him he had no concern about anything but the food he ate.

Now Joseph was handsome in form and appearance.⁷ And after a time his master's wife cast her eyes on Joseph and said, "Lie with me."⁸ But he refused and said to his master's wife, "Behold, because of me my master has no concern about anything in the house, and he has put everything that he has in my charge.⁹ He is not greater in this house than I am, nor has he kept back anything from me except you, because you are his wife. How then can I do this great wickedness and sin against God?"¹⁰ And as she spoke to Joseph day after day, he would not listen to her, to lie beside her or to be with her.

¹¹ But one day, when he went into the house to do his work and none of the men of the house was there in the house,¹² she caught him by his garment, saying, "Lie with me." But he left his garment in her hand and fled and got out of the house.¹³ And as soon as she saw that he had left his garment in her hand and had fled out of the house,¹⁴ she called to the men of her household and

said to them, "See, he has brought among us a Hebrew to laugh at us. He came in to me to lie with me, and I cried out with a loud voice.¹⁵ And as soon as he heard that I lifted up my voice and cried out, he left his garment beside me and fled and got out of the house."¹⁶ Then she laid up his garment by her until his master came home,¹⁷ and she told him the same story, saying, "The Hebrew servant, whom you have brought among us, came in to me to laugh at me."¹⁸ But as soon as I lifted up my voice and cried, he left his garment beside me and fled out of the house."

¹⁹ As soon as his master heard the words that his wife spoke to him, "This is the way your servant treated me," his anger was kindled.²⁰ And Joseph's master took him and put him into the prison, the place where the king's prisoners were confined, and he was there in prison.²¹ But the Lord was with Joseph and showed him steadfast love and gave him favor in the sight of the keeper of the prison.

Reader. The Word of the Lord.

People. Thanks be to God.

The Sermon

THE SACRAMENT OF HOLY BAPTISM

DEARLY BELOVED, Scripture teaches that we are by nature dead in our trespasses and sins. This is why our Savior Jesus Christ said, “Unless one is born of water and the Spirit, he cannot enter the kingdom of God,” and he commissioned the Church to “make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the Name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.” Here we ask our heavenly Father that Beatrice, being baptized with water, may be filled with the Holy Spirit, born again, and received into the Church as a living member of Christ’s body. Therefore, I urge you to call upon God the Father, through our Lord Jesus Christ, that of his abundant mercy he will grant to this candidate that which by nature she cannot have.

The Presentation

The Candidate for Holy Baptism will now be presented.

The Sponsors

We present Beatrice Elisa Kucks to receive the Sacrament of Baptism.

The minister asks the sponsors the following

TODAY, on behalf of this child, you shall make vows to renounce the devil and all his works, to trust God wholeheartedly, and to serve him faithfully. It is your task to see that Beatrice is taught, as soon as she is able to learn, the full meaning of all these vows, and of the Faith that you will profess as revealed in the Holy Scriptures. This child must put her trust in Christ, and to learn the Creeds, the Lord's Prayer, the Ten Commandments, and all other things which a Christian ought to know, believe, and do for the welfare of their soul. When she embraces all these, having become a disciple of Jesus, she is to come to the bishop to be confirmed, that she may be further strengthened by the Holy Spirit to serve Christ and his Kingdom. Are you willing and ready to undertake this? *The Sponsors say, I am, the Lord being my helper.*

Profession of Faith *The minister then examines the Candidates and Sponsors*

Question Do you renounce the Devil and all the spiritual forces of wickedness that rebel against God?

Answer I renounce them.

Question Do you renounce the empty promises and deadly deceits of this world which corrupt and destroy the creatures of God?

Answer I renounce them.

Question Do you renounce the sinful desires of the flesh that draw you from the love of God?

Answer I renounce them.

ALmighty God deliver you from the powers of darkness and evil, and lead you into the light and obedience of the kingdom of his Son, Jesus Christ our Lord. **Amen.**

Question Do you turn to Jesus Christ and confess him as your Lord and Savior?

Answer I do.

Question Do you joyfully receive the Christian Faith, as revealed in the Holy Scriptures of the Old and New Testaments?

Answer I do.

Question Will you obediently keep God's holy will and commandments, and walk in them all the days of your life?

Answer I will, the Lord being my helper.

The minister then addresses the congregation, first inviting them to stand.

WILL you who witness these vows do all in your power to support Beatrice in her life in Christ? *The congregation responds, We will.*

The minister then says to the congregation

LET us together join with this candidate in proclaiming our faith in the words of the ancient baptismal confession, the Apostles' Creed.

Minister Do you believe and trust in God the Father?

People I do. I believe in God the Father almighty, creator of heaven and earth.

Minister Do you believe and trust in Jesus Christ?

People I do. I believe in Jesus Christ, his only Son, our Lord. He was conceived by the Holy Spirit and born of the Virgin Mary. He suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried: He descended to the dead. On the third day he rose again. He ascended into heaven, and is seated at the right hand of the Father. He will come again to judge the living and the dead.

Minister Do you believe and trust in the Holy Spirit?

People I do. I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy catholic Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting. Amen.

The Baptismal Litany

LET us now pray for Beatrice who will receive the Sacrament of Baptism, that she may come to confess her faith in Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior.

We beseech you to hear us, Good Lord.

That all she may continue in the apostles' teaching and the fellowship, in the breaking of bread, and in the prayers.

That she may walk in a manner worthy of the calling to which she has been called, ever growing in faith and all heavenly virtues.

That she may proclaim by word and deed the Good News of God in Christ Jesus to a lost and broken world.

That as a living member of the Body of Christ, she may grow up in every way into him who is the head.

We beseech you to hear us, Good Lord.

That, looking to Jesus, she may run with endurance the race set before them, and at the last receive the unfading crown of glory.

We beseech you to hear us, Good Lord.

Look mercifully upon this your servant, Beatrice. Wash and sanctify her through your Holy Spirit that she, being delivered from destruction and received into the Ark of Christ's Church, would be made steadfast in faith, joyful through hope, and rooted in love. May she pass through the turbulent floods of this troublesome world and come into the land of everlasting life; through Jesus Christ our Lord. **Amen.**

In it your Son Jesus received the baptism of John in the River Jordan when the Holy Spirit descended upon him as a dove. We thank you, Father, for the water of Baptism. In it we are buried with Christ in his death. By it we share in his resurrection. Through it we receive the sign of regeneration by the Holy Spirit. Therefore in joyful obedience to your Son, we bring into his fellowship those who come to him in faith, baptizing them in the Name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. And now, O Father, sanctify this water by the power of your Holy Spirit. We pray that all who are baptized would be cleansed from sin, born again, and continue for ever faithful in the risen life of Jesus Christ our Savior. The People continue to kneel. The minister stands and continues.

He made there, by his one oblation of himself once offered, a full, perfect, and sufficient sacrifice, oblation, and satisfaction, for the sins of the whole world; and he instituted, and in his Holy Gospel commanded us to continue, a perpetual memory of his precious death and sacrifice, until his coming again. Hear us, merciful Father, and grant that we receiving these gifts from your creation, this bread and this wine, according to your Son our Savior Jesus Christ's institution, in remembrance of his death and passion, may be partakers of his most blessed Body and Blood; For on the night that he was betrayed, our Lord Jesus Christ took bread; and when he had given thanks, he broke it, and gave it to his disciples, saying, "Take, eat; this is my Body, which is given for you: Do this in remembrance of me." Likewise, after supper, Jesus took the cup, and when he had given thanks, he gave it to them, saying, "Drink this, all of you; for this is my Blood of the New Covenant, which is shed for you, and for many, for the forgiveness of sins: Whenever you drink it, do this in remembrance of me." **AMEN.**

Distribution of Communion. All baptized Christians of an understanding age who are admitted to the Sacrament within their own church are encouraged to receive it with us. We will bring both bread and wine to you.

The bread server says,

THE body of Christ which was given for you (preserve your body and soul unto everlasting life). *Or* Take and eat this in remembrance that Christ's body was given for you (and feed on him in your heart by faith with thanksgiving).

The wine server says,

THE blood of Christ which was shed for you (preserve your body and soul unto everlasting life). *Or* Take and drink this in remembrance that Christ's blood was shed for you (and be thankful).

A Prayer for Those Who Cannot Come to the Lord's Supper.

Dear Jesus, I believe that you are spiritually present to us in the Sacrament of your body and blood. Since I cannot now receive you sacramentally, minister to me by your Holy Spirit. I embrace you and unite myself wholly to you; permit not that I should ever be separated from you. Amen.
